## Isaiah 61:1-3 [NKJV]

<sup>1</sup> “The Spirit of the Lord God is upon Me,  
Because the Lord has anointed Me  
To preach good tidings to the poor;  
He has sent Me to heal the broken hearted,  
To proclaim liberty to the captives,  
And the opening of the prison to those who are bound;  
<sup>2</sup> To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord,  
And the day of vengeance of our God;  
To comfort all who mourn,

<sup>3</sup> To console those who mourn in Zion,  
To give them beauty for ashes,  
The oil of joy for mourning,  
The garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness;  
That they may be called trees of righteousness,  
The planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified.”

**Luke 4:14-21** [NKJV] *Jesus Begins His Galilean Ministry*

<sup>14</sup> Then Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit to Galilee, and news of Him went out through all the surrounding region. <sup>15</sup> And He taught in their synagogues, being glorified by all.

## *Jesus Rejected at Nazareth*

<sup>16</sup> So He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up. And as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read. <sup>17</sup> And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written:?”

18 “The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me,  
Because He has anointed Me  
To preach the gospel to the poor;  
He has sent Me to heal the broken hearted,  
To proclaim liberty to the captives  
And recovery of sight to the blind,  
To set at liberty those who are oppressed;

<sup>19</sup> To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord.”

<sup>20</sup> Then He closed the book, and gave it back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all who were in the synagogue were fixed on Him. <sup>21</sup> And He began to say to them, “Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing.” <sup>22</sup> So all bore witness to Him, and marvelled at the gracious words which proceeded out of His mouth. And they said, “Is this not Joseph’s son?”



## Psalm 34:1-4 [NKJV]

<sup>1</sup> I will bless the Lord at all times;  
His praise shall continually be in my mouth.

<sup>2</sup> My soul shall make its boast in the Lord;  
The humble shall hear of it and be glad.

<sup>3</sup> Oh, magnify the Lord with me,  
And let us exalt His name together.

<sup>4</sup> I sought the Lord, and He heard me,  
And delivered me from all my fears.

## 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 [NKJV]

<sup>16</sup> Rejoice always, <sup>17</sup> pray without ceasing, <sup>18</sup> in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.
