




**1 WHEN THINGS GO

Acts 12:6 NLT




Peter was therefore kept in prison,

for them.




Even them I will bring to My holy

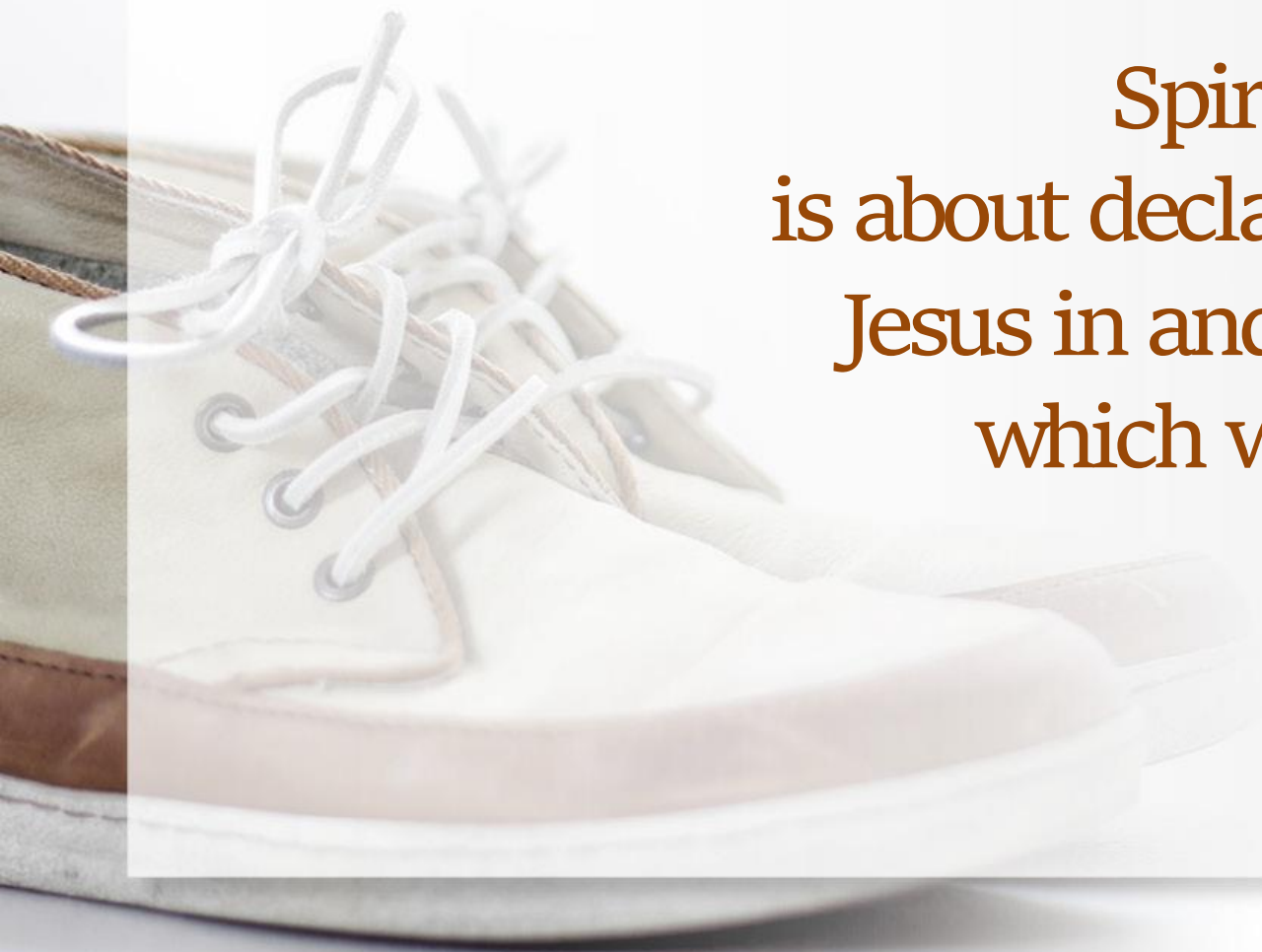



which we find ourselves.




Spiritual warfare

circumstances.




Spiritual warfare

ARE PRAYED**








**5 PRAYER MEETINGS
