- Attitude, kind of relationship or failure to relate.
- Opposite of acceptance
- Synonyms/phrases to define:

A feeling of being unwanted, excluded, worthless, not belonging, somehow on the outside looking in but never knowing how to get on the inside

# <u>ls 54:4-6</u> [ESV]

4 "Fear not, for you will not be ashamed; be not confounded, for you will not be disgraced; for you will forget the shame of your youth, and the reproach of your widowhood you will remember no more. 5 For your Maker is your husband, the LORD of hosts is his name; and the Holy One of Israel is your Redeemer, the God of the whole earth he is called. 6 For the LORD has called you like a wife deserted and grieved in spirit, like a wife of youth when she is cast off, says your God.

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#### 1. Nature and Cause

# Proverbs 18:14 [ESV]

A man's spirit will endure sickness, but a crushed spirit who can bear?

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# Proverbs 15:13 [ESV]

A glad heart makes a cheerful face, but by sorrow of heart the spirit is crushed.

#### 1. Nature and Cause

- Wife towards husband and husband toward wife
- Lack of love from one or both parents in childhood
- Child unwanted during pregnancy
- Child who does not receive/experience expressed warm, affectionate love from a parent.
- One child receives an unfair measure of love and affection.

Primary result — Inability to receive or communicate love.

# 1 John 4:18-19 [ESV]

18 There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not been perfected in love. 19 We love because he first loved us.

### Secondary results of rejection:

- A person who gives in
- A person who holds out
- A person who fights back

None of these reactions to rejection is a positive solution, it is defensive and simply cover up the hurt.

Lust (adultery, fornication, whoredom, harlotry, seduction, sexual impurity, homosexuality, lesbianism, masturbation, pornography, incest, fantasy lust, sodomy, uncleanness), fantasy, perversion, insecurity, inferiority, pride, vanity, ego, low self-esteem, self-accusation, depression, perfectionism, unfairness, guilt, shame, confusion, sensitiveness, inordinate affection for animals, fear, (all types), paranoia, indecision (procrastination, compromise), passivity, continual sadness, escapism, heartbreak, hopelessness, hyperactivity, insomnia.

# Isaiah 61:1 [ESV]

The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me, because the LORD has anointed me to bring good news to the poor; he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound.

# <u>Isaiah 53:4-6</u> [ESV]

4 Surely he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. 5 But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed. 6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

#### 3. God's Remedy

#### Aspects of this exchange:

- Jesus was punished for our sins so that we might experience forgiveness
- Jesus was wounded for our sickness that we might receive healing
- Jesus was made sin that we might receive forgiveness
- Jesus was made a curse that we might receive the blessing
- Jesus died our death that we might share in His life
- Ultimately Jesus was rejected by men and finally by God

# Isaiah 53:3 [ESV]

He was despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows and acquainted with grief; and as one from whom men hide their faces he was despised, and we esteemed him not.

# Matthew 27:45-46 [ESV]

45 Now from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land until the ninth hour. 46 And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, lema sabachthani?" that is, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"

#### Matthew 27:47-51 [ESV]

47 And some of the bystanders, hearing it, said, "This man is calling Elijah." 48 And one of them at once ran and took a sponge, filled it with sour wine, and put it on a reed and gave it to him to drink. 49 But the others said, "Wait, let us see whether Elijah will come to save him." 50 And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice and yielded up his spirit. 51 And behold, the curtain of the temple was torn in two, from top to bottom. And the earth shook, and the rocks were split.

# 4. Applying God's Remedy

- Forgive every person who rejected you and harmed you in any way. (Mark 11:25)
- Lay down the things rejection brought in it's train
- By an act of faith Accept that you are accepted in Christ. (Eph 1:4-6)
- Accept yourself

### Eph 2:19-22 [ESV]

19 So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, 20 built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, 21 in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord. 22 In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit.

### 5. Acceptance by God's People

#### The only barrier is rebellion:

- Lay down rebellion
- Stop going your own way, doing your own thing
- Realise you need the body and seek you place.
