
Genesis 12:1–3 (ESV)




See how very much our Father loves us, for he calls us his children, and that is what we are! But the people who belong to this world don't recognize that we are God's children because they don't know him.

Romans 2:29 (NLT)











Ephesians 1:16-20 (NRSV)

Weekly small group notes from Sunday Sermon (SG duration - 1 to 1.5hrs)

- 1. Welcome: Introduce SG to visitors and ask group to share on the following- What are you loyal to due to your Parents (e.g. car brand, tradition, hobby etc.)
- 2. Worship together: 1 or 2 Worship Songs and open SG in prayer asking the father to reveal His Story to us.
- 3. SG Questions: (only let 2 or 3 people answer a specific question for time sake and give everyone a turn)
 - a) The Beginning and the end: Read Revelation 21:5–7: What do you think God is saying when He declares that He is the beginning and the end? Is he subject to time or is time and history subject to His Control? b) Coming out of the world: Genesis 12:1–3 & John 15:19: What did becoming part of the Father's story mean for Abraham and what does it mean for us? How does it affect our cultural practices and what we are loyal to?
 - c) A family Story: 1 John 3:1 & Romans 2:29: What are key elements of becoming part of the Father's story and remaining in it.
 - d) Your Story: Matthew 26:6–13, Ephesians 1:16–20 & Isaiah 6:8: Does anything limit you from becoming Part of God's story?
- Turn together in groups of 2: Share with each other if how you feel about being used by God and what you sense God is saying to you by the Spirit about His plan through your life.
 - Pray for each other for words of knowledge and for shame and fear to not hold us back from His Story
