









Weekly small group notes from Sunday Sermon (Duration - 1 to 1.5hrs)

1. Welcome: Introduce SG members to visitors and ask group to share on the following: Have you ever experienced God's presence?
2. Worship together: 1 or 2 Worship Songs and open SG in prayer asking the father to reveal to us what being on Mission with Him looks like?

SG Questions: (let 2 or 3 people answer a specific question and give everyone a turn)
 - a) The Father's mission through the Son: Read Luke 4:42-43 & 1 John 4:14; On whose mission was Jesus and what was His mission?
 - b) The Son's mission continued: Read John 20:20-21, Mark 3:14-15 & Matthew 28:18-20 ; What mission is Jesus inviting us to join Him on and what does it look like in your life?
 - c) The Promise that outweighs the cost: Matthew 28:20 & Psalm 73:23-26: What is a sure promise that comes with obedience to pursue His mission?
4. Remind the SG that God's promise stands if we believe it and appropriate it.. Even if it doesn't affect our feelings immediately. His Presence on mission outweighs any cost that could come as a result of obedience.

Pray for each and commission another into the mission according to Matthew 28:18-20
