What can we take with us when we die? Nothing. Except relationships.

# The battle (is for relationship)

Evil in the world? Their mission: Hell on earth. Destroy relationship.

**Heaven or Hell?** \*Relationships that work = closest you will get to heaven on earth. Broken relationships = closest you'll get to hell on earth.

- Ladies wear pink glasses en hearing aids. Speak pink and hear pink. Men wear blue glasses and hearing aids. Speak and hear blue. Put the two together? <u>Serious miscommunication</u>.
- Resolving the conflict: Before we can speak the other's language, we need to put on <u>another</u> pair of glasses. We need to put on <u>yellow glasses</u> or Holy Spirit glasses. See what God sees, hear what God hears.
- **Distracted:** Men are on a mission for anything and everything except true relationship.

### The love of our lives (our treasure)

Proverbs 18:22 (NLT) 22 The man who finds a wife finds a treasure, and he receives favour from the LORD.

A man of honour values his wife highly. She is a treasure.

Proverbs 21:20 (NKJV) <sup>20</sup> There is desirable treasure, and oil in the dwelling of the wise, But a <u>foolish man</u> squanders it.

- We need a value shift.
- o **Inspired to change! who wants to find a treasure**, but then lose it because he was a jerk? *Everybody wants the treasure, but few are willing to become the catch themselves.*
- o **A rich man?** Somebody with authentic meaningful relationships. **A poor man?** All the stuff in the world, but shallow / empty relationships.

Proverbs 15:17 (The Message) 17 Better a bread crust shared in love than a slab of prime rib served in hate.

• **Broken relationships** – makes the best taste bad.

## Our mission – to be a princess maker

What is honour? Honour is to esteem someone highly. To value somebody as important. A man of honour gives honour.

Honour is starts in the heart – an unstoppable, <u>unchangeable position you take in your heart</u>. She is valuable. Irrespective of her performance.

1 Peter 3:7 (NLT) <sup>7</sup> In the same way, you husbands <u>must give honour</u> to your wives.

- **Give honour to the wife:** An impartation of honour. An impartation of value.
- **Princess makers:** We don't simply marry a princess. We are princess makers. We cause the women in our lives to become everything God has destined them to be.
- Men, we are royalty. Jesus is the king. We are princes that can impart royalty to a simple peasant girl. Like we were.

• You can't give what you don't have. Find your identity in Christ.

Proverbs 19:14 (NLT) <sup>14</sup> Fathers can give their sons an inheritance of houses and wealth, but <u>only the LORD</u> can give an understanding wife.

- It is God who works in their hearts, to change them into His image. Only the Lord can do it.
- Why go through all the trouble? It will benefit you.

Proverbs 21:19 (NKJV) <sup>19</sup> Better to dwell in the wilderness, than with a contentious and angry woman.

• Men of honour: it is in our hands. We will determine what they become...

#### Our mission - to become a man of honour

Ephesians 5:25–33 (The Message) <sup>25</sup> Husbands, go all out in your love for your wives, exactly as Christ did for the church—a love marked by giving, not getting. <sup>26</sup> Christ's love makes the church whole. His words evoke her beauty. Everything he does and says is designed to bring the best out of her, <sup>27</sup> dressing her in dazzling white silk, radiant with holiness. <sup>28</sup> And that is how husbands ought to love their wives. They're really doing themselves a favor—since they're already "one" in marriage.

- Go all out in your love for your wives: Hold nothing back. Don't be half-hearted.
- Exactly as Christ did for the church Jesus is our example. We are Jesus men.
  - o \*God's love is the ultimate eye-opener. We cannot love what we don't value highly!
  - Love? Is to see someone as infinitely precious.
- A love marked by giving, not getting: not what you can get, but what you can give.
  - o **Speaking loud and clear: "I value you."** how? Through what you do serve her!
- Christ's love makes the church whole our love makes the woman in our lives whole.
  - \*God's love is the ultimate enabler: God's love doesn't only enable us to see, but also enables us to look after this special treasure.
  - How would you treat a real princess? Well, do it....Treat her like a lady / like a princess...always: Make it a priority!

#### Conclusion

A man of honour considers the woman he loves to be of infinite value. **His mission?** Become a man of honour and to be a princess maker.
