The Proverbs 31 woman...

What is a virtuous woman?

A woman of valour in the sense of all forms of excellence **Valour** = courage in the face of danger, especially in battle **Excellence** = the quality of being extremely good or outstanding

My own definition: A virtuous woman is not your average woman, not acting like everyone around her, but operating on a different level of excellence on the battlefield, <u>not necessarily winning every battle, but winning the war.</u>

In relationships we can win battles eg. arguments, but we can lose the war, loose the person's heart

WHAT ARE THE WEAPONS A VIRTUOUS WOMAN?

Proverbs 31:25-26

<u>Strength</u> and <u>honour</u> are her **clothing**; she shall <u>rejoice in time to come</u>. She opens her mouth with <u>wisdom</u>, and on her tongue is the law of <u>kindness</u>.

1. Strength – we need to put it on, a decision we make

a place of security in God where not storm or crisis will move you

Psalm 62:5

My soul, wait silently for God alone, for my expectation is from Him.

A woman of virtue put her expectation on God.

Often we have a big black hole and we expect men (boyfriend, fiancé, husband) to fill it. They can't. A virtuous woman is a wise person who primarily goes to God for physical, emotional and spiritual needs.

2. Honour – we need to put it on – a decision we make

Ephesians 5:33(AMP)

...let the wife see that she <u>respects and reverences</u> her husband (that she notices him, regards him, honours him, prefers him, venerates, and esteems him; and that she defers to him, praises him, and loves and admires him exceedingly)

as a married woman

- stop trying to change the man in your life and trust the Lord to do the work
- respect the man in your life unconditionally, taking the risk and trusting the Lord for the outcome, treat him like a king even if he does not act as a king
- don't treat him like a child, even if he acts like a child –
- stop being your husband's teacher, mother and "holy spirit
- Don't compare your husband to any other man

as a single woman

- stop competing with men
- to respect the men in your life, starting with your brothers and dad

- 3. **Rejoicing in time to come** ('laughing at the days to come') a result after you've put on strength and honour
 - Fully confident that God is in control
 - Trusting the Lord with all your heart and not leaning on your own understanding Proverbs 3:5
 - We trust in the Lord that even if your husband makes the wrong decision, God will protect us.

4. Wisdom - "...she opens her mouth with wisdom..."

We need to ASK God for wisdom

James 1:19 (AMP)

Let every man be quick to hear [a ready listener], slow to speak, slow to take offense and to get angry.

5. Kindness – "...on her tongue is the law of kindness..."

Proverbs 25:15 (AMP) ...soft speech breaks down the most bonelike resistance **Proverbs 15:1(AMP)** a soft answer turns away wrath...

1 Peter 3:1-5 – gentle and quiet spirit

<u>Gentle & quiet spirit:</u> A wife's obedience is not from intimidation, but from a quiet confidence, which is the fruit of trust in God. We have to make a choice to trust in the Lord. We do not manipulate, do not control, let go of our ideas, our timing, our way

A woman with a gentle & quiet spirit with kindness on her tongue might not win every battle (argument), but she is going to win her man's heart.

RESULT OF BEING A VIRTUOUS WOMAN

Proverbs 31: 30&31 (NLT)

...a woman who fears the LORD will be greatly praised. Reward her for all she has done. Let her deeds publicly declare her praise.

Proverbs 31: 11-12, 28

- Praise from your husband & your children
- Your husband will safely trusts you and you will be good for him all the days of your life
- You will be treated like a princess
