2 Corinthians 3:17 (NKJV) ¹⁷ Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.

True praise?

Psalm 100:1-5 (NKJV) 1 Make a <u>ioyful shout</u> to the LORD, all you lands! 2 ...Come before His presence with singing. 3 Know that the LORD, He is God; ... 4 Enter into His gates with <u>thanksgiving</u>, and into His courts <u>with praise</u>....For the LORD is good...

- o Praising God has everything to do with His presence.
- Understanding His greatness.

Praise is our natural response to greatness revealed.

Psalm 47:1–2, 5-8 (NKJV) ¹ Oh, clap your hands, all you peoples! Shout to God with the voice of triumph! ² For the LORD Most High is awesome; He is a great King over all the earth. God has gone up with a shout, the LORD with the sound of a trumpet. ⁶ Sing praises to God, sing praises! Sing praises to our King, sing praises! ⁷ For God is the King of all the earth; Sing praises with understanding. ⁸ God reigns over the nations; God sits on His holy throne.

The greater our understanding the <u>more meaningful</u> our praise

A house of glory - True praise transforms the church into a house of glory.

- God in our midst
- Kingdom comes, because the King comes.
- Christ's victory manifests here and now *Voice of triumph = the voice of faith. Sing as if we have <u>already</u> won. Sing as if God has already done it all.
 - o Fact: it doesn't look as if we have won. Truth: Yet we have won. God has already won.
 - *Faith in action.
