Introduction

Can church be beautiful?

Ephesians 5:25–27 (NKJV) ²⁵ Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also <u>loved the church</u> and <u>gave Himself for her</u>, ²⁶ that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, ²⁷ that He might <u>present her to Himself a glorious church</u>, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she <u>should be holy</u> and <u>without blemish</u>.

Slow down (Matt 16:13-18)

Matthew 16:13–14 (NKJV) ¹³ When Jesus came into the <u>region of Caesarea Philippi</u>, He asked His disciples, saying, "Who do men say that I, the Son of Man, am?" ¹⁴ So they said, "Some say John the Baptist, some Elijah, and others Jeremiah or one of the prophets."

- We can all be so busy that we miss Jesus completely...
- Word: Slow down. God turning our faces to Jesus. "Look at Me"

The Beauty of church

Matthew 16:15 (NKJV) ¹⁵ He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?"

- Why did Jesus ask them this question? Why didn't He merely tell them?
- Its' personal: How <u>you</u> see Jesus will determine if the church will be beautiful. Each of us <u>together</u> <u>make up</u> the church.
- *Jesus is beautiful. When He becomes beautiful to us (personally / individually), then His church becomes beautiful.

The Spirit-fed church

Matthew 16:16–17 (NKJV) ¹⁶ Simon Peter answered and said, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." ¹⁷ Jesus answered and said to him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah, for flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but My Father who is in heaven.

The church is experiencing a spiritual famine. An anaemic / starving church is not beautiful.

- The word alone, or even the truth alone doesn't bring life change.
- Blessed are you! The source of this truth is all-defining! *
- People are fed when the word explodes into their hearts by the Holy Spirit.
- *Jesus is the living Word. When the Spirit causes the word to come alive, then the famine is broken and we are fed with Christ Himself.
- When Jesus is beautiful to us, then the church becomes beautiful as well.

The church of the little rocks

Matthew 16:18 (NKJV) ¹⁸ And I <u>also say to you</u> that you are Peter, **and on this rock** I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it.

- The glorious church consists out of little rocks. *The little rocks together make up the church.*
- *A little rock on its own? Can't build much with that.

- The beauty of the church? Everyone is needed. Every little rock is needed.
- I will build My church: Jesus is building His church.

The Triumphant church

Gates of Hades shall not prevail against it

• The church is unstoppable when Jesus is the centre, the foundation and rock upon which she is built.

2 Corinthians 2:14–15 (NKJV) ¹⁴ Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place.

• When we see Jesus and come to love Him, then we become beautiful.

The church becomes beautiful, when Jesus is beautiful to us.
