


Genesis 1:1 (ESV) ¹ In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.






Futile in their thinking



Natural selection


The principle of natural selection states that the organisms, e.g. plants and animals, that are better suited to survive in a certain environment, will produce more offspring than others of the same kind. The fittest organisms therefore propagate their characteristics.

According to its kind



According to its kind

Genesis 1:24–25 (ESV) ²⁵ And God made the beasts of the earth according to their kinds and the livestock according to their kinds, and everything that creeps on the ground according to its kind. And God saw that it was good.

Made in His image
