We need a dream

- The Christian life is not a call to a life of comfort, but to a life of sacrifice.
- Do you have something calling you to live the higher life?
- *There cannot be fire, without a sacrifice. We provide the sacrifice, God provides the fire.

Alienated from the life of God

Ephesians 4:17–24 (NKJV) ¹⁷ This I say, therefore, and testify in the Lord, that you should <u>no longer walk</u> as the rest of the Gentiles walk, <u>in the futility of their mind</u>, ¹⁸ having their **understanding darkened**, being <u>alienated from the life of God</u>, because of **the ignorance that is in them**, because of the **blindness of their heart**; ¹⁹ who, being past feeling, have <u>given themselves over to lewdness</u>, to work all uncleanness with greediness.

- For the believer everything has changed! A new timeline and a new identity. We become a part of a Heavenly family, we become a Heavenly citizen, and we receive a royal lineage.
- The power of a new identity: "For sons, the heavens are always open."

Learned Christ

²⁰ **But you have not so learned Christ**, ²¹ **if indeed** you have <u>heard Him</u> and have <u>been taught by Him</u>, as the truth is in Jesus: ²² **that you put off**, concerning your former conduct, **the old man which grows corrupt** according to the deceitful lusts, ²³ and <u>be renewed in the spirit of your mind</u>, ²⁴ and that you **put on the new man** which was <u>created according to God</u>, in true righteousness and holiness.

- "Not so learned Christ" believers are different from the rest of the world. Jesus Christ is their source and defines them.
- A transformation happens when we hear Christ and are taught by Him. The old is cast off and the new man is put on.
- "The truth is in Jesus" Who we really are, is found in Christ. He is our source and anchor.

Living by Revelation - eyes to see heaven's reality

Ephesians 1:16–19 (ESV) ¹⁶ I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers, ¹⁷ that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, **the Father of glory**, <u>may give you</u> the <u>Spirit of wisdom and of **revelation in**</u> the knowledge of him, ¹⁸ having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know <u>what is the hope</u> to which he has called you, what are the <u>riches of his glorious inheritance</u> in the saints, ¹⁹ and what is the <u>immeasurable greatness of his power</u> toward us who believe, according to the working of his great might

- We need "eyes" to see!
- Spirit of Wisdom + Revelation seeing Him, but also the wisdom to translate that into daily living.
- When we see, when our eyes are opened to realise everything God has given us, then it isn't hard to sacrifice. Then to become a living sacrifice is a joy!
- Our role? We like Paul can pray for others and impart the blessing of seeing.

Experiencing God - we grow when we taste His goodness

1 Peter 2:1–5 (ESV) ¹ So <u>put away</u> all malice and all deceit and hypocrisy and envy and all slander. ² Like newborn infants, long for the <u>pure spiritual milk</u>, that by it you may grow up into salvation— ³ **if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is good.** ⁴ As you come to him, a living stone rejected by men but in the sight of God **chosen and precious**, ⁵ you yourselves <u>like living stones</u> are <u>being built up as a spiritual house</u>, to be a holy priesthood, **to offer spiritual sacrifices** acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

- The Word of God causes us to grow up / grow thereby
- "If indeed" "you have tasted that the Lord is good". When we experience the goodness of God, literally tasting it, then we will truly grow. Christ comes alive to us.
- When we hear Him, when we are taught by Him and when we taste His goodness, then we will become living sacrifices!

Psalm 81:10–13 (NKJV) ¹⁰ I am the LORD your God, Who brought you out of the land of Egypt; **Open your mouth wide, and I will fill it.** ¹¹ "But My people <u>would not heed My voice</u>, And Israel would have none of Me. ¹² So I gave them over to their own stubborn heart, To walk in their own counsels. ¹³ "**Oh, that My people would listen to Me**, That Israel would walk in My ways!
