Introduction

*Your authority is directly related to the measure of the Spirit in your life.

Authority defined - The right to act or speak in certain ways: "We were born to rule - rule over creation, over darkness - to plunder hell and establish the rule of Jesus wherever we go by preaching the gospel of the kingdom."

Why don't we walk in our authority? If the enemy can't deceive us out of our authority, then he will try to intimidate us.

- (1) Deceive enemy tricks us We don't realize what it means to be a child of God.
- (2) Intimidate can't deceive us, then intimidate us. Wrong focus.

Result of intimidation – we glorify the powers of evil or circumstances in our lives.

- "We are often more convinced of our unworthiness than we are of His worth. Our inability takes on greater focus than does His ability. But the same One who called fearful Gideon a Valiant Warrior and unstable Peter a Rock has <u>called us the Body of his beloved Son</u> on earth. That has to count for something."
- Break out of the victim mentality.

Walk in your authority

"The invasion of God into impossible situations comes through a people who have received power from on high and learn to release it into the circumstances of life."

Get a mission. Walk through that door, take the step of faith.

Psalm 27:1–2 (NKJV) ¹ The LORD is **my light** and my salvation; **Whom shall I fear?** The LORD is **the strength** of my life; of whom shall I **be afraid?** When the wicked came against me to eat up my flesh, My enemies and foes, <u>They stumbled and fell.</u>

*Look down and get discouraged. Look around and get distracted. Look up and and get direction! Brian Houston.

Angels fulfil His Word

We are not left alone or to our own devices. God has given us partners.

Psalm 103:19–22 (NKJV) ¹⁹ The LORD has <u>established</u> His throne in heaven, And <u>His kingdom rules over all</u>. ²⁰ Bless the LORD, you His angels, Who <u>excel in strength</u>, **who do His word**, <u>Heeding the voice of His word</u>. ²¹ Bless the LORD, all you His hosts, You ministers of His, **who do His pleasure**. ²² Bless the LORD, **all His works**, In all places of His dominion. *Aggressive in the Spirit. Kingdom of heaven suffers violence and the violent take it by force.

- **Violent defined** (Merriam Webster dictionary) marked by extreme force or sudden intense activity (violent attack) / Notably furious or vehement (a violent denunciation)
- John initiated or instigated warfare in the heavenlies.
