#### Divided heart.

Luke 10:38–42 (NKJV) <sup>38</sup> Now it happened as they went that He entered a certain village; and a certain woman named **Martha welcomed Him into her house**. <sup>39</sup> And she had a sister called Mary, who also **sat at Jesus' feet** and **heard His word**. <sup>40</sup> But Martha <u>was distracted</u> with **much serving**, and she approached Him and said, "Lord, <u>do You not care</u> that my sister has left me to serve alone? Therefore tell her to help me." <sup>41</sup> And Jesus answered and said to her, "Martha, Martha, **you are worried and troubled about many things**. <sup>42</sup> But **one thing is needed**, and Mary has **chosen** that good part, which will <u>not be taken away</u> from her."

**Contrasting two types of believers.** Those who live <u>from</u> the secret place & those who live <u>from their own strength</u> outside the secret place. Worried and troubled about many things.

\*Martha welcomed Jesus into her house. That is a good place to start.

Martha was distracted. Many believers find themselves in the same boat. Distracted.

"Many will be shocked one day. Many will be deeply saddened when they realise they have wasted their lives. When they realise the lives they could have impacted, yet didn't."

# \*What distracts you?

Every moment is an opportunity to draw closer to God. Every moment.

<sup>41</sup> And Jesus answered and said to her, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and troubled about many things."

worry, *merimnao* (mer-im-*nah*-oh); Strong's #3309: From *merizo*, "to divide into **parts."** The word suggests **a distraction**, <u>a preoccupation</u> with things causing anxiety, stress, and pressure.

• \*\*Before you do for Me, first come to Me.

## One thing is needed

Mary, who sat at Jesus' feet and heard His word. The Secret Place.

**Matthew 5:6** <sup>6</sup> But you, when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, **pray to your** Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly.

- Where is God? God is found in the secret place!
- Our Greatest victories are won in the Secret Place. That which happens in the secret place determine the rewards we receive from heaven that EVERYONE sees.

Secret place: The Father who is in the Secret Place. Who speaks in the secret place (psalm 81:7). Who sees / hears in the Secret place. A place of safety (Psalm 27:5) God is found in the secret place. (Psalm 91:1, Matthew 5:6)

For a powerfully effective life, this is needed. This One thing.

"Most strategic thing you can do with your life – separate yourself to the secret place of prayer." (Banning Liebscher from Jesus Culture).

In the secret place you get what you cannot get anywhere else. From that place flows the glory of God. That is where heaven meets earth.

#### Choose

It is possible to stay at His feet. Continuously. Make a daily connection with Heaven and then stay there.

42 But one thing is needed, and Mary has chosen that good part, which will not be taken away from her."

Every moment of the day is an opportunity to draw closer to God, or to step further away.

To say "yes" to God, you need to say "no" to a whole bunch of other things.

"Stop selling your hearts." Vision the Lord showed me: People bowing before shrines. In the lounge kneeling before the TV. In the garage, worshipping car. On the lawn in front of house bowing down. In front of shops in the mall. Selling our hearts. Distracted. "Stop selling your hearts"

We are called to possess all things, but to be possessed by none, except the Most High God.

"The man who has God for his treasure has <u>all things in **One**</u>. Many ordinary treasures may be denied him, or if he is allowed to have them, the enjoyment of them will be so tempered that they will <u>never be necessary for his happiness</u>. Or if he must see them go, one after one, he will scarcely feel a sense of loss, for having **the Source of all** things he has **in One all satisfaction**, all pleasure, all delight. Whatever he may lose he has actually lost nothing, for **he now has it all in One**, and he has it purely, legitimately and forever." AW Tozer
