

*Likewise, two people lying close together can keep each other warm. But how can one be warm alone?*



Proverbs 27:6 (NLT) <sup>6</sup> *Wounds from a sincere friend are better than many kisses from an enemy.*



*The LORD will create a new thing on earth - a woman will surround a man.*


C: Covering friend

Amos 3:3 (NLT) <sup>3</sup> *Can two people walk together without agreeing on the direction?*


D: Dangerous friend

*"Jesus kissed Judas and called him friend. Great leaders know how to forgive." John Bevere*




