Matthew 24:4–5 (NKJV) <sup>4</sup> And Jesus answered and said to them: "Take heed that no one deceives you. <sup>5</sup> For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and will deceive many.



## The Voice of Truth

John 18:37–38 (NKJV) <sup>37</sup> Pilate therefore said to Him, "Are You a king then?" Jesus answered, "You say rightly that I am a king. For this cause I was born, and for this cause I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth.

#### The Voice of Truth

Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice." 38 Pilate said to Him, "What is truth?" And when he had said this, he went out again to the Jews, and said to them, "I find no fault in Him at all.

# "Me, deceived?"

Jeremiah 17:9–10 (NKJV) <sup>9</sup> "The heart is deceitful above all things, And desperately wicked; Who can know it? <sup>10</sup> I, the LORD, search the heart, I test the mind, Even to give every man according to his ways, According to the fruit of his doings.

# "Me, deceived?"

Trust: We can only get out of deception if we trust someone else more than we trust our own judgement.

#### The Gates of Hell

James 3:13–16 (NKJV) <sup>13</sup> Who is wise and understanding among you? Let him show by good conduct that his works are done in the meekness of wisdom. <sup>14</sup> But if you have bitter envy and self-seeking in your hearts, do not boast and lie against the truth.

#### The Gates of Hell

15 This wisdom does not descend from above, but is earthly, sensual, demonic. 16 For where envy and self-seeking exist, confusion and every evil thing are there.

- 1. Hidden sins and secrets
- 2. Envy & selfish ambition

#### **Test of Deception**

"When a leader operates out of ungodly fear and self-preservation, then it opens the door for demonic inspiration."

## Committing great evil

Matthew 27:16–18 (NKJV) <sup>16</sup> And at that time they had a notorious prisoner called Barabbas. <sup>17</sup> Therefore, when they had gathered together, Pilate said to them, "Whom do you want me to release to you? Barabbas, or Jesus who is called Christ?"

18 For he knew that they had handed Him over because of envy.

## Committing great evil

Matthew 27:21–22 (NKJV) <sup>21</sup> The governor answered and said to them, "Which of the two do you want me to release to you?" They said, "Barabbas!" <sup>22</sup> Pilate said to them, "What then shall I do with Jesus who is called Christ?" They all said to him, "Let Him be crucified!"

## **Seven Signs**

James 3:17–18 (NKJV) <sup>17</sup> But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy. <sup>18</sup> Now the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.

- 2. Peacable Live loosely!

Luke 14:33 (NKJV) <sup>33</sup> So likewise, whoever of you does not forsake all that he has cannot be My disciple.
