

Step 1: Moving out of Egypt

Exodus 14:12-14 (AMP) Moses told the people, <u>Fear not; stand still</u> (firm, confident, undismayed) and see the salvation of the Lord which He will work for you today. For the Egyptians you have seen today you shall never see again. <u>The Lord will</u> fight for you, and you shall <u>hold your</u> peace and remain at rest.
