5. Meditating on His promises
Hope is not an optimistic outlook or
wishful thinking without any
foundation, but a <u>confident</u>
<u>expectation</u> based on solid
certainty. **Biblical hope rests on**<u>God's promises</u>.

# KEEPING OUR HOPE ALIVE

### Romans 4:18-21 (NLT)

Even when there was no reason for hope, Abraham **kept hoping**—believing that he would become the father of many nations... And Abraham's faith did not weaken, even though at about 100 years of age, he figured his body was as good as dead...

and so was Sarah's womb.

Abraham never wavered in believing God's promise.

In fact, his faith grew stronger, and in this he brought glory to God.

He was **fully convinced** that **God is able to do whatever he promises**.
