



## Believe till breakthrough

Hebrews 10:23 (NKJV) <sup>23</sup> *Let us **hold fast** the confession of our hope **without wavering**, for He who promised is faithful.*

## Believe till breakthrough

Romans 4:20-21 *He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, and **being fully convinced** that what He had promised He was also able to perform. And therefore **“it was accounted to him for righteousness.”***

## Believe till breakthrough

Galatians 3:5-7 (NKJV) <sup>5</sup> *Therefore He who **supplies the Spirit to you** and **works miracles among you**, does He do it by the works of the law, or **by the hearing of faith?*** <sup>6</sup> *just as Abraham “believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.”* <sup>7</sup> *Therefore know that **only those who are of faith are sons** of Abraham.*

## “All the promises is for me.”

2 Corinthians 1:20 (NKJV) <sup>20</sup> *For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us.*

John 4:35 (NKJV) <sup>35</sup> ***Do you not say**, ‘There are still four months and then comes the harvest’? Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are **already white for harvest!***

## The Harvest is now!

**John 4:6**<sup>6</sup> *Now Jacob's well was there. Jesus therefore, being wearied from His journey, sat thus by the well. It was about the sixth hour.*

## The Harvest is now!

John 4:17–19 (NKJV)<sup>17</sup> *The woman answered and said, "I have no husband." Jesus said to her, "You have well said, 'I have no husband,'<sup>18</sup> for you have had five husbands, and the one whom you now have is not your husband; in that you spoke truly."<sup>19</sup> The woman said to Him, "Sir, I perceive that You are a prophet.*

Mark 5:5-8<sup>5</sup> *And always, night and day, he was in the mountains and in the tombs, crying out and cutting himself with stones.<sup>6</sup> When **he saw Jesus from afar, he ran and worshiped Him.***

## The Harvest is now?

<sup>7</sup> *And he cried out with a loud voice and said, "What have I to do with You, Jesus, **Son of the Most High God?** I implore You by God that **You do not torment me.**"<sup>8</sup> For He said to him, "Come out of the man, unclean spirit!"*

## Known in hell

Acts 19:15-16<sup>15</sup> *And the evil spirit answered and said, "**Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are you?"**<sup>16</sup> Then the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, overpowered them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded.*

Acts 8:4–8 (NKJV)<sup>4</sup> *Therefore those who were scattered went everywhere **preaching the word.**<sup>5</sup> Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria and **preached Christ to them.**<sup>6</sup> And the multitudes with one accord heeded the things spoken by Philip, **hearing and seeing the miracles which he did.***

## Great joy in that city!

<sup>7</sup> For unclean spirits, crying **with a loud voice**, came out of many who were possessed; and **many** who were paralyzed and lame were healed. <sup>8</sup> And there was **great joy** in that city.
