1 Samuel 17:24 (NKJV) <sup>24</sup> And all the men of Israel, when they saw the man, fled from him and were dreadfully afraid.

1 Samuel 17:26 (NKJV) <sup>26</sup> Then David spoke to the men who stood by him, saying, "What shall be done for the man who kills this Philistine and takes away the reproach from Israel?

For who is this uncircumcised

Philistine, that he should defy the armies of the living God?"

1 Samuel 17:40 (NKJV) <sup>40</sup> Then he took his staff in his hand; and he chose **for himself five smooth** stones <u>from the brook</u>, and put them in a shepherd's bag, in a pouch which he had, and his sling was in his hand. And he drew near to the Philistine.

### Prophesy!

1 Samuel 17:42–46 (NKJV) <sup>42</sup> And when the Philistine looked about and saw David, he disdained him; for he was only a youth, ruddy and good-looking. <sup>43</sup> So the Philistine said to David, "Am I a dog, that you come to me with sticks?"

### Prophesy!

And the Philistine cursed David by his gods. <sup>44</sup> And the Philistine said to David, "Come to me, and I will give your flesh to the birds of the air and the beasts of the field!" <sup>45</sup> Then David said to the Philistine, "You come to me with a sword, with a spear, and with a

javelin. **But I come to you in the**name of the LORD of hosts, the
God of the armies of Israel, whom
you have defied. <sup>46</sup> This
day the LORD will deliver you into
my hand, and I will strike you and
take your head from you.

### **Prophesy!**

And this day I will give the carcasses of the camp of the Philistines to the birds of the air and the wild beasts of the earth, that all the earth may know that there is a God in Israel.

## Victory!

1 Samuel 17:50 (NKJV) <sup>50</sup> So David prevailed over the Philistine with a sling and a stone, and struck the Philistine and killed him.
