Ephesians 1:1-2 (Passion Translation) *Dear friends, ¹My name is Paul, and I was chosen by God to be an apostle of Jesus, the Messiah. ²I'm writing this letter to all the devoted believers who have been made holy by being one with Jesus, the Anointed One...*

Ephesians

...May God himself, the heavenly Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, release grace over you and impart total well-being into your lives.

God Quest

Ephesians 1:3 (Passion translation) *Everything heaven contains has already been lavished upon us as a love gift from our wonderful heavenly Father...*

God Quest

*...the Father of our Lord Jesus – all because he sees us **wrapped into Christ**. This is why we celebrate him with all our hearts!*

Family

Ephesians 2:18 - 22 (NLT) ¹⁸ Now **all of us can come to the Father** through the same Holy Spirit because of what Christ has done for us. ¹⁹ So now you Gentiles are no longer strangers and foreigners. You are citizens along with all of God's holy people.

Family

You are members of God's family.
²⁰ *Together, we are his house, built on the foundation of the apostles and the prophets. And the cornerstone is Christ Jesus himself.* ²¹ *We are carefully joined together in him, becoming a holy temple for the Lord.*

Ephesians 2:18 (NLT) ¹⁸ *Now **all of us** can come to the Father through the same Holy Spirit because of what Christ has done for us.*

No longer strangers

Ephesians 2:19–22 (NLT) ¹⁹ *So now you Gentiles are no longer strangers and foreigners. You are citizens along with **all of God's holy people**. You are **members of God's family**.* ²⁰ *Together, we are his house*

Built on the Foundation

Ephesians 2:20–21 (NLT) ²⁰ *Together, we are his house, built on the foundation of the apostles and the prophets. And the cornerstone is Christ Jesus himself.* ²¹ *We are carefully joined together in him*

Built on the Foundation

*“This first detailed description of the early Christians is wonderfully revealing. The followers of Jesus, who had been baptized by the Holy Spirit, **literally devoted themselves to communication and unity with God and with each other.**”*

Built on the Foundation

Acts 2:41–42 (The Message) ⁴¹
That day about three thousand took him at his word, were baptized and were signed up. ⁴² They committed themselves to the teaching of the apostles, the life together, the common meal, and the prayers.

Built on the Foundation

Fellowship (life together), koinonia (koy-nohn-ee-ah); Sharing, unity, close association, partnership, participation, a communion, a fellowship, contributory help, the brotherhood. **Koinonia is a unity brought about by the Holy Spirit.**

Built on the Foundation

In *koinonia* the individual shares in common an intimate bond of fellowship with the rest of the Christian society. **Koinonia cements the believers to the Lord Jesus and to each other.**

Ephesians 2:20–21 (NLT) ²⁰
