## Walk worthy Ephesians 4:1–6 (NLT) <sup>1</sup> Therefore I, a prisoner for serving the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of your calling, for you have been called by God. <sup>2</sup> Always be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other's faults

because of your love. <sup>3</sup> Make every effort to keep yourselves united in the Spirit, binding yourselves together with peace. <sup>4</sup> For there is one body and one Spirit, just as you have been called to one glorious hope for the future.

### **Generous love**

:2b (Passion translation) always demonstrate gentleness and generous love toward one another, especially toward those who may try your patience...

### Jesus is there

Matthew 25:34–40 (NLT) <sup>34</sup> "Then the King will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the Kingdom prepared for you from the creation of the world. <sup>35</sup> For I was hungry, and you fed me. I was thirsty, and you gave me a drink.

### Jesus is there

I was a stranger, and you invited me into your home. <sup>36</sup> I was naked, and you gave me clothing. I was sick, and you cared for me. I was in prison, and you visited me.' <sup>37</sup> "Then these righteous ones will reply, 'Lord, when did we ever see you hungry and feed you?

Or thirsty and give you something to drink? <sup>38</sup> Or a stranger and show you hospitality? Or naked and give you clothing? <sup>39</sup> When did we ever see you sick or in prison and visit you?'

### Overlooked or ignored

Matthew 25:40 (The Message) 40
Then the King will say, 'I'm telling the solemn truth: Whenever you did one of these things to someone overlooked or ignored, that was me—you did it to me.'

### **Equipped to build**

Ephesians 4:12–13(NLT) <sup>12</sup> Their responsibility is **to equip God's people** to <u>do his work and build up</u> <u>the church</u>, the body of Christ. <sup>13</sup> This will continue until we all come to such **unity** in our faith and

John 15:12–14 (NKJV) <sup>12</sup> This is My commandment, that **you love one another as I have loved you**. <sup>13</sup> Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends. <sup>14</sup> You are My friends if you do whatever I command you.
