Know - ginosko (ghin- oce- koe)- to perceive, understand, recognize, gain knowledge - basically means the recognition of truth by personal experience

Truth- alétheia -truth, but not merely truth as spoken; truth of idea, reality, sincerity, truth in the moral sphere, divine truth revealed to man, straightforwardness.

Authentic relationship

Free- eleutheroo (el-yoo- ther- ah- oh)- to liberate, acquit, set free, deliver- in NT used exclusively for Jesus setting believers at liberty from dominion of sin.

“And you shall recognize the truth by personal experience and this reality of truly knowing Jesus shall make you free from dominion of sin and we now have eternal life with Jesus”

Authentic relationship
