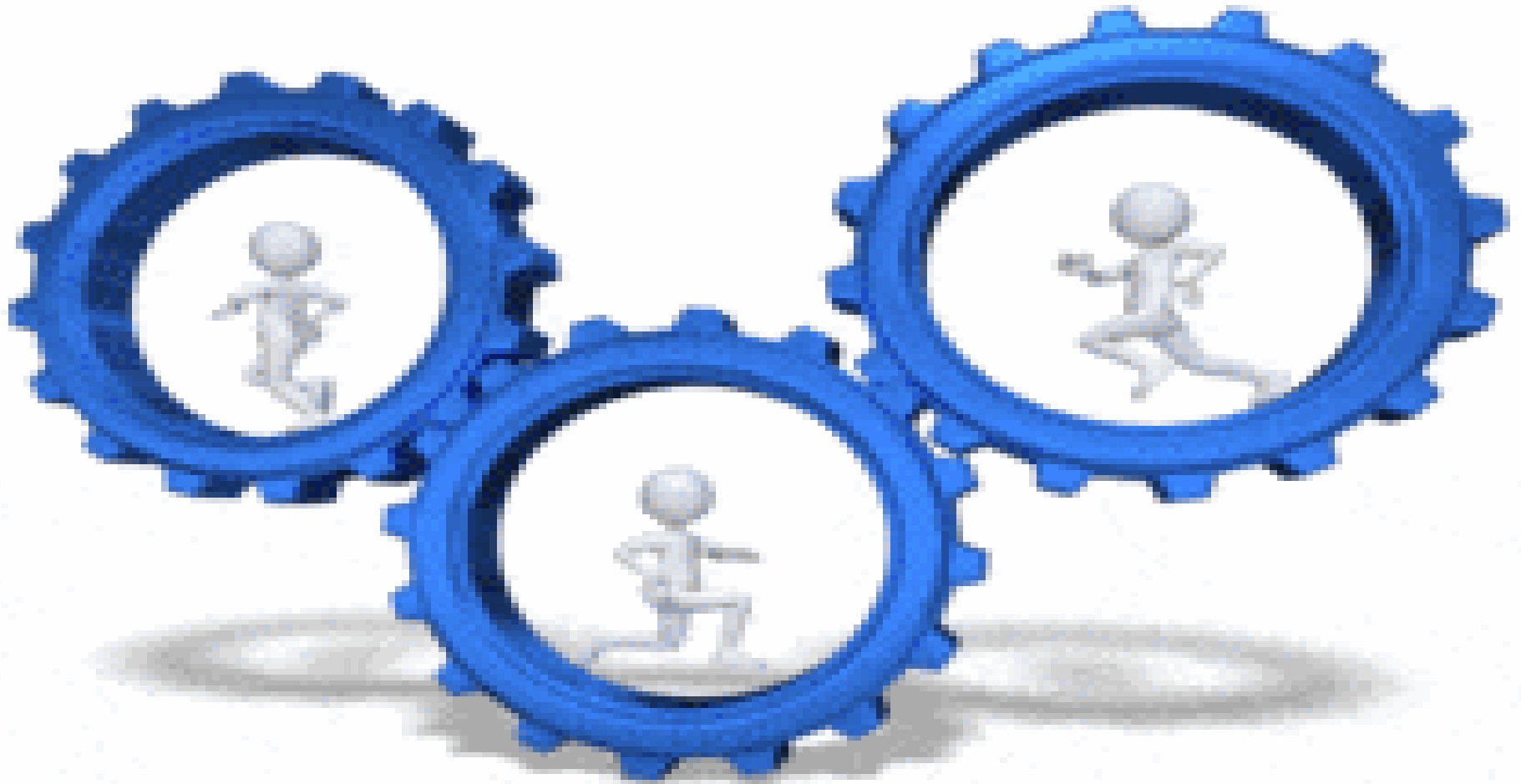

MAKE DISCIPLES

“And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, “All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.” Amen.”

MAKE DISCIPLES

The term "disciple" is derived from the Greek word mathetes, which means a pupil (of a teacher) or an apprentice to a master craftsman). A disciple is a learner, one who follows the teaching and the teacher

We are responsible to create learners and then to teach them

To do this we have to motivate people to want to learn, receive and grow so that we can teach, equip and train them.
