

### **TWO ROADS**

Matthew 7:13–14 (NKJV) <sup>13</sup> "Enter by the **narrow gate**; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. <sup>14</sup> Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are <u>few who find it</u>.

### **TWO OPTIONS**

Genesis 10-13 <sup>10</sup> Lot took <u>a long</u> look at the fertile plains of the Jordan Valley in the direction of Zoar. The whole area was well watered everywhere, like the garden of the LORD or the beautiful land of Egypt. (This was before the LORD destroyed Sodom and Gemariah.)

### **TWO OPTIONS**

<sup>11</sup> Lot chose for himself the whole Jordan Valley to the east of them. He went there with his flocks and servants and parted company with his uncle Abram. <sup>12</sup> So Abram settled in the land of Canaan, and Lot **moved his tents to a place near Sodom** and settled among the cities of the plain.

<sup>13</sup> But the people of this area were extremely wicked and constantly sinned against the LORD.

### WALK IN THE SPIRIT

Galatians 5:16–17 (NKJV) <sup>16</sup> I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and <u>you</u> <u>shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.</u> <sup>17</sup> For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish.

# THE SINFUL NATURE

Galatians 5:19–21 (NLT) <sup>19</sup> When you follow the desires of your sinful nature, the results are very clear: sexual immorality, impurity, lustful pleasures, <sup>20</sup> idolatry, sorcery, hostility, quarreling, jealousy, outbursts of anger, selfish ambition, dissension, division,

<sup>21</sup> envy, drunkenness, wild parties, and other sins like these. Let me tell you again, as I have before, that anyone living that sort of life <u>will</u> not inherit the Kingdom of God.

### THE BETTER WAY

Psalm 16:11 (NKJV) <sup>11</sup> You will show me the path of life; In Your presence is fullness of joy; At Your right hand are pleasures forevermore.

#### THE BETTER WAY

Galatians 5:22–23 (NKJV) <sup>22</sup> <u>But</u> the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> gentleness (meekness), self-control. Against such there is no law.

Colossians 3:14–15 (NKJV) <sup>14</sup> But above all these things **put on love**, which is <u>the bond of perfection</u>. <sup>15</sup> And let **the peace of God rule in your hearts**, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful.
