

LOVING FATHER

John 3:16–17 (NKJV) ¹⁶ For God so loved the world that **He gave His only begotten** Son, that <u>whoever</u> believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. ¹⁷ For God <u>did not send His Son into the world</u> <u>to condemn</u> the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.

CONDEMNATION DEFINED

A statement or expression of very strong and definite criticism or disapproval.

CONDEMNATION

- 1. No way out
- 2. Disconnects us from God
- 3. Steals our strength and joy
- 4. Pulls us down

NO CONDEMNATION

Romans 8:1 (NLT) ¹ So **now** there is **no condemnation** for those who belong to Christ Jesus.

YOU ARE CELEBRATED

Zephaniah 3:17 (NKJV) ¹⁷ The LORD your God in your midst, The Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing."

JOIN THE PARTY

Colossians 1:21–22 (NLT) ²¹ *This includes you who <u>were once far away from God</u>. You were his enemies, separated from him by your evil thoughts and actions.* ²² *Yet now he has reconciled you to himself through the death of Christ in his physical body.*

JOIN THE PARTY

As a result, **he has brought you** into his own presence, and **you are holy and** <u>blameless</u> as you stand before him <u>without a single fault.</u>
