

MOVING MOUNTAINS

Mountain 1:

The longer the problem existed, the smaller the chance of breakthrough or healing.

Mountain 2:

You cannot pray for someone if you have the same condition and is not yet healed.

Mountain 3:

God has forgotten about me and my condition.

LIKE A LEPROUS SORE

Leviticus 13:2-8 (NKJV)1And the Lord spoke to Moses and Aaron, saying: 2"When a man has on the skin of his body a swelling, a scab, or a bright spot, and it becomes on the skin of his body like a leprous sore, then he shall be brought to Aaron the priest... 3The priest shall examine the sore on the skin of the body; and if the hair on the sore has turned white, and the sore appears to be deeper than the skin of his body, it is a leprous sore.

LIKE A LEPROUS SORE

Then the priest shall examine him, and pronounce him unclean. 4But if the bright spot is white on the skin of his body, and does not appear to be deeper than the skin, and its hair has not turned white, then the priest shall isolate the one who has the sore seven days. 5And the priest shall examine him on the seventh day;

LIKE A LEPROUS SORE

and indeed if the sore appears to be as it was, and the sore has not spread on the skin, then the priest shall isolate him another seven days. 6Then the priest shall examine him again on the seventh day; and indeed if the sore has faded, and the sore has not spread on the skin, then the priest shall pronounce him clean; it is only a scab, and he shall wash his clothes and be clean.

LIKE A LEPROUS SORE

7But if the scab should at all spread over the skin, after he has been seen by the priest for his cleansing, he shall be seen by the priest again. 8And if the priest sees that the scab has indeed spread on the skin, then the priest shall pronounce him unclean. It is leprosy.

LIKE A LEPROUS SORE

<u>Like</u> a leprous sore: deal with the diagnosis of 21 afflictions of the skin which are referred to in the inclusive term "leprosy".

Leprosy denoted a variety of skin ailments, including psoriasis.

Leviticus associated holiness with wholeness. Skin diseases therefore made one unclean because he was not pure and not whole.



FOR THE GLORY OF GOD

John 9:2-3 (NKJV)

"And His disciples asked Him, saying, Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind? Jesus answered "Neither this man nor his parents sinned, but that the works of God should be revealed in him."

SHIFTING MOUNTAIN ONE

John 5:5,9 (NLT) "One of the men lying there had been sick for <u>thirty-eight years</u> . . . instantly the man was healed."

Luke 1:7,24 (NKJV) "They had no children because Elizabeth was unable to conceive, and they were both very old . . . soon afterward his wife, Elizabeth, became pregnant"

SHIFTING MOUNTAIN ONE

Luke 13:12-13 (NLT) "'She had been bent double for <u>eighteen years</u> and was unable to stand up straight. When Jesus saw her, he called her over and said, 'Dear woman, you are healed of your sickness!' Then he touched her, and instantly she could stand straight."

SHIFTING MOUNTAIN ONE

Mark 5:25,26,34 (NKJV) Now a certain woman had a flow of blood for twelve years, and had suffered many things from many physicians. She had spent all that she had and was not better, but rather grew worse.... And He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made your well. Go in peace, and be healed of your affliction."

SHIFTING MOUNTAIN TWO

Mark 9:23 (NKJV) ...all things are possible to him who believes.

Acts 6:8 (NKJV) ...and Stephen, <u>full of faith</u> and power, did great wonders and signs among the people.

Mark 10:27 (NKJV) ...for with God all things are possible.
