Isaiah 49:15 (NKJV) <sup>15</sup> "Can a woman forget her nursing child, and not have compassion on the son of her womb? Surely they may forget, **Yet I will not forget you.** 

## **FATHER GOD**

Hebrews 13:5–6 (NLT) <sup>5</sup> Don't love money; be satisfied with what you have. For God has said, "I will never fail you. I will never abandon you." <sup>6</sup> So we can say with confidence, "The LORD is my helper, so I will have <u>no fear</u>. What can <u>mere</u> people do to me?"

## **PRODIGAL SON**

Luke 15:1–2 (NLT) <sup>1</sup> Tax collectors and other notorious sinners often came to listen to Jesus teach. <sup>2</sup> This made the Pharisees and teachers of religious law complain that he was associating with such sinful people—even eating with them!

## **PRODIGAL SON**

Luke 15:17-19 <sup>17</sup> "When he finally came to his senses, he said to himself, 'At home even the hired servants have food enough to spare, and here <u>I am dying of hunger</u>! <sup>18</sup> I will go home to my father...

### **PRODIGAL SON**

<sup>20</sup> "So he returned home to his father. And while he was still a long way off, his father saw him coming. Filled with love and compassion, he <u>ran to his son</u>, <u>embraced him, and kissed him</u>.

### **PRODIGAL SON**

<sup>21</sup> His son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against both heaven and you, and I am <u>no longer worthy of being called your</u> <u>son.'</u><sup>22</sup> "But his father said to the servants, 'Quick! Bring the finest robe in the house and put it on him. Get a ring for his finger and sandals for his feet.

### **PRODIGAL SON**

<sup>23</sup> And kill the calf we have been fattening. We must celebrate with a feast, <sup>24</sup> for this <u>son of mine was dead and</u> <u>has now returned to life.</u> He was lost, but <u>now he is found.</u>' So the party began.

## **OLDER BROTHER**

<sup>25</sup> "Meanwhile, the older son was in the fields working. When he returned home, he heard music and dancing in the house, <sup>26</sup> and he asked one of the servants what was going on. <sup>27</sup> 'Your brother is back,' he was told, 'and your father has killed the fattened calf. We are celebrating because of his safe return.'

## **OLDER BROTHER**

<sup>7 28</sup> "The older brother was angry and wouldn't go in. His father came out and begged him, <sup>29</sup> but he replied, 'All these years <u>I've slaved for you</u> and never once refused to do a single thing you told me to. And in all that time <u>you never gave me</u> <u>even one young goat</u> for a feast with my friends.

# **OLDER BROTHER**

<sup>30</sup> Yet when this son of yours comes back after squandering your money on prostitutes, you celebrate by killing the fattened calf!' <sup>31</sup> "His father said to him, 'Look, dear son, you have always stayed by me, and everything I have is yours.

## **OLDER BROTHER**

<sup>32</sup> We had to celebrate this happy day. For your brother <u>was dead</u> and has come <u>back to life</u>! He was lost, but now he is found!' "
