"Therefore, take up the full armour of God, so that you will be able to resist in the evil day, **and having done everything, to stand firm.**" (ESV)


James 1:12

1. Acknowledge that there is a time for everything.

Ecclesiastes 3:2-8

2. Crack the Test: Instructions

Numbers 20:8-12 (NLT)

"You and Aaron must **take the staff and assemble the entire community**. As the people watch, **speak to the rock over there, and it will pour out its water**. You will provide enough water from the rock to satisfy the whole community and their livestock." So Moses did as he was told. He took the staff from the place where it was kept before the Lord. Then he and Aaron summoned the people to come and gather at the rock."

2. Crack the Test: Attitude

Numbers 14:23

James 1:5

"But if any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all generously and without reproach, and **it will** be given to him." (NASB)

Hebrews 10:24-25

"Let us think of ways to **motivate one another to acts of love and good works**. And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but **encourage one another**, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near." (NLT)

James 5:16
