EQUIP THE SAINTS

Ephesians 4:11–16 (NKJV) ¹¹ *And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers,* ¹² *for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ,*

EQUIP THE SAINTS

¹³ *till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ;*

Ephesians 4:7 (NKJV) ⁷ *But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift.*

PASTORAL PARADIGM

Everybody is a somebody in Christ and they are worthy of me washing their feet.

EMPOWERED TO SERVE



John 13:3–5 (NKJV) ³ Jesus, **knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands**, and that He had come from God and **was going to God**, ⁴ rose from supper and laid aside His garments, took a towel and girded Himself. ⁵ After that, He poured water into a basin and **began to wash the disciples' feet**, and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded.

EXAMPLE TO FOLLOW



John 13:12–17 (NKJV) ¹² So when He had washed their feet, taken His garments, and sat down again, He said to them, "Do you know what I have done to you?" ¹³ You call Me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, for so I am. ¹⁴ If I then, your Lord and Teacher, **have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet.**

EXAMPLE TO FOLLOW



¹⁵ For I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you. ¹⁶ Most assuredly, I say to you, a servant is not greater than his master; nor is he who is sent greater than he who sent him. ¹⁷ If you know these things, **blessed are you if you do them.**
