2 Corinthians 12:9 And He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, **for My strength is made perfect in weakness.**" Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, **that the power of Christ may rest upon me.**

Isaiah 40:28-31 *Have you not known? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the Lord, The Creator of the ends of the earth, **Neither faints nor is weary.** His understanding is unsearchable. **He gives power to the weak, And to those who have no might He increases strength.***

**WAIT IN THE WILDERNESS**

*Even the youths shall faint and be weary, And the young men shall utterly fall, **But those who wait on the Lord Shall renew their strength;** They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint.*
