HOW TO TEST

All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness.

(2 Timothy 3:16)

- Does it agree with Scripture?
- Is it consistent with the character and nature of God?
- Does it resonate with me?
- How do family, friends, and leaders who love me feel about the word?
- Do I trust the source?
- What was the spirit in which the word was delivered?
- Does it glorify God and draw me closer to Jesus?
- Based upon these criteria, does this word or parts of it accurately reflect what God is speaking to me right now?
- Type out the final version



BIGGER PICTURE

All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness.

(2 Timothy 3:16)

- Circle any words that refer to who God says you are. We call these "identity words."
- Underline any promises that God is making directly to you.
- Make note of any conditions or requirements on your part.
- Mark any words that indicate timing or seasons.
- Make a list of any metaphors or biblical references that you want to research further.
- Count how many times a word, idea, or theme is repeated to work out major and minor themes within your prophetic words.
