Romans 10:13-15;17 (NIV) 14 And how can they hear without someone <u>preaching</u> to them? 15 And how can anyone preach unless they are <u>sent</u>?....

## Where Does Faith Come From?

Romans 10:13-15;17 (NIV) 17 Consequently, <u>faith</u> comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ."

#### WHAT IS FAITH?

James 2:14-17 (NIV) <sup>14</sup> "What good is it, my brothers and sisters, if people <u>claim</u> to have <u>faith</u> but have <u>no deeds</u>? Can such faith save them? <sup>15</sup> Suppose a brother or sister is without clothes and daily food?



#### WHAT IS FAITH?

<sup>16</sup> If one of you says to them, 'Go in peace; keep warm and well fed," but does nothing about their physical needs, what good is it? <sup>17</sup> In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action is dead.'"

Ephesians 2:8-10 (NIV) <sup>®</sup> For it is by grace you have been saved, through <u>faith</u>-and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God-. <sup>®</sup> by works, so that no one can boast.

<sup>1</sup> "As Jesus looked up, He saw the rich putting their gifts into the temple treasury. <sup>2</sup>He also saw a poor widow put in two very small copper coins.

<sup>3</sup>'Truly I tell you,' He said,'this poor widow has put in more than all the others. 4 All of these people gave their gifts out of their wealth; but she out of her poverty put in all she had to live on.'"
