Romans 10:13-15;17 (NIV) <sup>14</sup>And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? <sup>15</sup>And how can anyone preach unless they are sent?....

## Where Does Faith Come From?

Romans 10:13-15;17 (NIV) <sup>17</sup>Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ."

## WHAT IS FAITH?

James 2:14-17 (NIV) <sup>14</sup>"What good is it, my brothers and sisters, if people claim to have faith but have no deeds? Can such faith save them? <sup>15</sup>Suppose a brother or sister is without clothes and daily food?

## WHAT IS FAITH?

<sup>16</sup>If one of you says to them, 'Go in peace; keep warm and well fed,' but does nothing about their physical needs, what good is it? <sup>17</sup>In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action is dead."

## NOT BY WORKS

Ephesians 2:8-10 (NIV) <sup>8</sup> For it is by grace you have been saved, through **faith**-and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God-. <sup>9</sup> by works, so that no one can boast.

## NOT BY WORKS

<sup>10</sup> For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

## TRUE GIVING

<sup>1</sup> "As Jesus looked up, He saw the rich putting their gifts into the temple treasury. <sup>2</sup> He also saw a poor widow put in two very small copper coins.

## TRUE GIVING

<sup>3</sup> "Truly I tell you," He said, "this poor widow has put in more than all the others. <sup>4</sup> All of these people gave their gifts out of their wealth; but she out of her poverty put in all she had to live on."
