Ephesians 1:3 (TPT)

Everything heaven contains has already been lavished upon us as a love gift from our wonderful heavenly Father, the Father of our Lord Jesus – all because he sees us wrapped into Christ. This is why we celebrate him with all our hearts!



Ephesians 2:18 - 22 (NLT)

18 Now all of us can come to the Father through the same Holy Spirit because of what Christ has done for us. 19 So now you Gentiles are no longer strangers and foreigners. You are citizens along with all of God's holy people. You are members of God's family.

²⁰ Together, we are <u>his house</u>, built on the foundation of the apostles and the prophets. And the cornerstone is Christ Jesus himself. ²¹ We are carefully joined together in him, becoming a holy temple for the Lord.

²² Through him you Gentiles are also being made part of this dwelling where God lives by his Spirit.

¹⁸ Now **all of us** can **come to the Father** through <u>the same Holy Spirit</u> because of what Christ has done for us.

Ephesians 2:19 (NLT)


