1 Corinthians 12:27–28 (NKJV)

Acts 2:41–42 (The Message)

Life Together = fellowship

Fellowship (life together), *koinonia* (koy-nohn-ee-ah); Strong's #2842: Sharing, unity, close association, partnership, participation, a communion, a fellowship, contributory help, the brotherhood.
