OBEDIENCE TO THE CALL

Have you been **obedient** to the **last instruction** you have received from the Lord?

OBEDIENCE

Zechariah 3:6 (NKJV) This is the word of the Lord to Zerubbabel: "Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit, says the Lord of hosts".

ENCOURAGEMENT

Zechariah 4:8-9 (NKJV) Moreover the word of the Lord came to me, saying: "The hands of Zerubbabel have laid the foundation of this temple; **his hands shall also finish it**."

PRACTICALLY

- Spend time with encouraging people.
- Attend events where you will receive a prophetic word.
- Value the prophetic word.

PRACTICALLY
