- Tuning into God's radio station
- Responding to your alarm clock

- 1. Still small voice
- 1 Kings 19:11-12 (NKJV) And behold, the Lord passed by, and a great and strong wind tore into the mountains and broke the rocks in pieces before the Lord, but the Lord was not in the wind;

and after the wind an earthquake, but the Lord was not in the earthquake; and after the earthquake a fire, but the Lord was not in the fire; and after the fire a still small voice. (a delicate whispering voice)

Colossians 3:15 (AMP) And let the peace (soul harmony which comes) from Christ rule (act as umpire continually) in your hearts...

3. The Bible

Hebrews 4:12 (NKJV) For the Word of God is <u>living</u> and powerful...

4. Dreams and visions (pictures)

Acts 2:17 (NKJV) "And it shall come to pass in the last days" says God, "that I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh.

Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your young men shall see **visions** and your old men shall dream **dreams**.

5. When believers meet
Hebrews 10:25 (TPT) This is not the
time to pull away and neglect
meeting together, as some have
formed the habit of doing. In fact,
we should come together even
more frequently.

6. Godly counsel

Proverbs 11:14 (NKJV) Where there is no counsel, the people fall, but in the <u>multitude of counsellors</u> there is <u>safety</u>.
