THE WILL OF GOD?

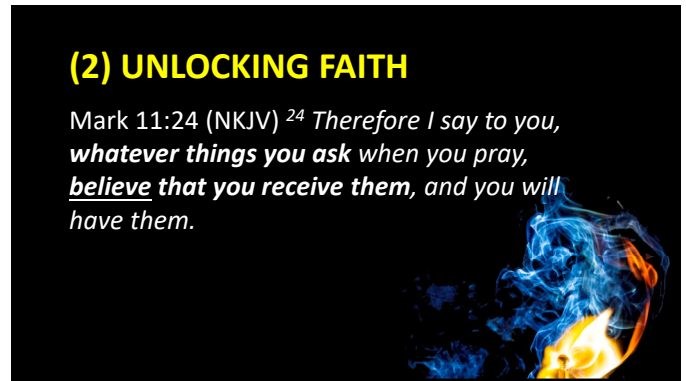
