...<sup>37</sup> 'Anyone who loves their father or more than me is not worthy of me; anyone who loves their son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. <sup>38</sup> Whoever does not take up their cross and follow me is not worthy of me. <sup>39</sup> Whoever finds their life will lose it, and whoever loses their life for my sake will find it.

## gather I scatter

- We 'come' to Jesus so that we can 'go' with Jesus.
- In 'coming' to Jesus we learn to yoke with Jesus
- And we 'go' with Jesus so that we can help others to 'come' to Jesus.
- When others 'come' to Jesus we experience the joy of 'coming' to him all over again.

## the snowball effect

- · Jesus calls two brothers Matthew 4
- Jesus calls the other ten disciples Mark 3
- Jesus sends out the 12 Matthew 11 / Luke 9
- Jesus appoints and sends out 72 others Luke 10
- Pentecost 3000 who 'comes' to Jesus Acts 2

#### the snowball effect

Acts 2:41-42, 46-47

"41 Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day

<sup>42</sup> They devoted themselves to the apostles' teachings and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer...

<sup>46</sup> Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, <sup>47</sup> praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those were being saved.
