- **Woman at the well**

John 4:19-26

¹⁹ The woman said to Him, Sir, I perceive that you are a prophet. ²⁰ Our fathers worshiped in this mountain, and you say that in Jerusalem is the place where men ought to worship. ²¹ Jesus said to her, Woman, believe Me, the hour is coming when you shall neither worship the Father in this mountain nor yet at Jerusalem. ²² You worship what you do not know; we know what we worship, for salvation is of the Jews. ²³ But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers shall worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father seeks such to worship Him. ²⁴ God is a spirit, and they who worship Him must worship in spirit and in truth. ²⁵ The woman said to Him, I know that Messiah is coming, who is called Christ. When He has come, He will tell us all things. ²⁶ Jesus said to her, I AM, the One speaking to you.

⁵ And a certain man was there, who had an infirmity thirty-eight years. ⁶ When Jesus saw him lying, and knowing that he had spent much time, He said to him, Do you desire to be made whole? ⁷ The infirm man answered Him, Sir, when the water is troubled; I have no one to put me into the pool. But while I am coming, another steps down before me. ⁸ Jesus says to him, Rise, take up your bed and walk. ⁹ And immediately the man was made whole and took up his bed and walked.
