A. 1. To invoke blessing

Genesis 24:60

⁶⁰ And they blessed Rebekah and said to her: "Our sister, may you become The mother of thousands of ten thousands; And may your descendants possess The gates of those who hate them."

Genesis 27:27

²⁷ And he came near and kissed him; and he smelled the smell of his clothing, and blessed him and said: "Surely, the smell of my son Is like the smell of a field Which the LORD has blessed."

2. **Berach** – to speak up to someone / receive down from

Eulogeo - to speak well of / praise / extol / give thanks

3. a) It is NOT good wishes / wishes for 'good luck', RATHER a prophetic decree by one with authority to release it.

E.g.

Genesis 27: Isaac → Jacob & Esau Genesis 48-49: Jacob → sons Deuteronomy 33: Moses → nation

b) The power of the invocation

Numbers 6:22-27 NIV

²² The LORD said to Moses, ²³ "Tell Aaron and his sons, 'This is how you are to bless the Israelites. Say to them: ²⁴ "'"The LORD bless you and keep you; ²⁵ the LORD make his face shine upon you and be gracious to you; ²⁶ the LORD turn his face towards you and give you peace."' ²⁷ "So they will put my name on the Israelites, and I will bless them."

God the blessor

Genesis 1:22, 28

²² And God blessed them, saying, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the waters in the seas, and let birds multiply on the earth." ²⁸ Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

Deuteronomy 7:7-9

⁷The LORD did not set His love on you nor choose you because you were more in number than any other people, for you were the least of all peoples; ⁸ but because the LORD loves you, and because He would keep the oath which He swore to your fathers, the LORD has brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you from the house of bondage, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt. ⁹Therefore know that the LORD your God, He is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and mercy for a thousand generations with those who love Him and keep His commandments;

Deuteronomy 7:13-15
