Joel 3:9-11

⁹Proclaim this among the nations: "Prepare for war! Wake up the mighty men, Let all the men of war draw near, Let them come up. ¹⁰Beat your plowshares into swords And your pruning hooks into spears; Let the weak say, 'I am strong.'" ¹¹Assemble and come, all you nations, And gather together all around. Cause Your mighty ones to go down there, O LORD.

The stakes are high

Joel 3:13-14

¹³Put in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe. Come, go down; For the winepress is full, The vats overflow—For their wickedness is great." ¹⁴Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision! For the day of the LORD is near in the valley of decision.

³⁶But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd.

Matthew 9:37

³⁷Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. ³⁸"Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest."

Have you come to be sent?

Matthew 10:1

¹And when He had called His twelve disciples to Him, He gave them power over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease.

For the glory of God

Matthew 15:30

³⁰Then great multitudes came to Him, having with them the lame, blind, mute, maimed, and many others; and they laid them down at Jesus' feet, and He healed them. ³¹So the multitude marveled when they saw the mute speaking, the maimed made whole, the lame walking, and the blind seeing; and they glorified the God of Israel.

1. Don't be intimidated by the multitude

Matthew 15:32-33

³²Now Jesus called His disciples to Himself and said, "I have compassion on the multitude, because they have now continued with Me three days and have nothing to eat. And I do not want to send them away hungry, lest they faint on the way." ³³Then His disciples said to Him, "Where could we get enough bread in the wilderness to fill such a great multitude?"

2. Make a peace with your inadequacy

Matthew 15:34-35

³⁴Jesus said to them, "How many loaves do you have?" And they said, "Seven, and a few little fish."

³⁵So He commanded the multitude to sit down on the ground.³⁶And He took the seven loaves and the fish and gave thanks, broke them and gave them to His disciples; and the disciples gave to the multitude.

3. Keep your heart soft

Matthew 18:24-35

²⁴"And when he had begun to settle accounts, one was brought to him who owed him ten thousand talents. ²⁵"But as he was not able to pay, his master commanded that he be sold, with his wife and children and all that he had, and that payment be made. ²⁶"The servant therefore fell down before him, saying, "Master, have patience with me, and I will pay you all." ²⁷"Then the master of that servant was moved with compassion, released him, and forgave him the debt.²⁸"But that servant went out and found one of his fellow servants who owed him a hundred denarii; and he laid hands on him and took him by the throat, saying, "Pay me what you owe!"²⁹"So his fellow servant fell down at his feet and begged him, saying, "Have patience with me, and I will pay you all." ³⁰"And he would not, but went and threw him into prison till he should pay the debt.³¹"So when his fellow servants saw what had been done, they were very grieved, and came and told their master all that had been done.³²"Then his master, after he had called him, said to him, "You wicked servant! I forgave you all that debt because you begged me. ³⁴"And his master was angry, and delivered him to the torturers until he should pay all that was due to him. ³⁵"So My heavenly Father also will do to you if each of you, from his heart, does not forgive his brother his trespasses."

4. Rinse your eyes
