##### **Mark 6:7-10**

<sup>7</sup>And He called the twelve to Himself, and began to send them out two by two, and gave them power over unclean spirits. <sup>8</sup>He commanded them to take nothing for the journey except a staff — no bag, no bread, no copper in their money belts — <sup>9</sup>but to wear sandals, and not to put on two tunics. <sup>10</sup>Also He said to them, "In whatever place you enter a house, stay there till you depart from that place.

##### **Mark 6:11-13**

<sup>11</sup>"And whoever will not receive you nor hear you, when you depart from there, shake off the dust under your feet as a testimony against them. Assuredly, I say to you, it will be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrah in the day of judgment than for that city!" <sup>12</sup>So they went out and preached that people should repent. <sup>13</sup>And they cast out many demons, and anointed with oil many who were sick, and healed them.

<sup>21</sup>Now when Jesus had crossed over again by boat to the other side, a great multitude gathered to Him; and He was by the sea. <sup>22</sup>And behold, one of the rulers of the synagogue came, Jairus by name. And when he saw Him, he fell at His feet <sup>23</sup>and begged Him earnestly, saying, "My little daughter lies at the point of death. Come and lay Your hands on her, that she may be healed, and she will live." <sup>24</sup>So Jesus went with him, and a great multitude followed Him and thronged Him.
