### A simple woman

#### **John 4:27-42**

<sup>27</sup>And at this point His disciples came, and they marveled that He talked with a woman; yet no one said, "What do You seek?" or, "Why are You talking with her?" <sup>28</sup>The woman then left her waterpot, went her way into the city, and said to the men, <sup>29</sup>"Come, see a Man who told me all things that I ever did. Could this be the Christ?" <sup>30</sup>Then they went out of the city and came to Him. <sup>31</sup>In the meantime His disciples urged Him, saying, "Rabbi, eat." <sup>32</sup>But He said to them, "I have food to eat of which you do not know." <sup>33</sup>Therefore the disciples said to one another, "Has anyone brought Him anything to eat?" <sup>34</sup>Jesus said to them, "My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to finish His work. <sup>35</sup>"Do you not say, 'There are still four months and then comes the harvest'? Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest! <sup>36</sup>"And he who reaps receives wages, and gathers fruit for eternal life, that both he who sows and he who reaps may rejoice together. <sup>37</sup>"For in this the saying is true: 'One sows and another reaps.' <sup>38</sup>"I sent you to reap that for which you have not labored; others have labored, and you have entered into their labors." <sup>39</sup>And many of the Samaritans of that city believed in Him because of the word of the woman who testified, "He told me all that I ever did." <sup>40</sup>So when the Samaritans had come to Him, they urged Him to stay with them; and He stayed there two days. <sup>41</sup>And many more believed because of His own word. <sup>42</sup>Then they said to the woman, "Now we believe, not because of what you said, for we ourselves have heard Him and we know that this is indeed the Christ, the Savior of the world."

### Our secret weapon

#### **Revelation 12:9-11**

<sup>9</sup>So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast out with him. <sup>10</sup>Then I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, "Now salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our God day and night, has been cast down. <sup>11</sup>"And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.
