## Exodus 21:1-6

<sup>1</sup>Now these are the rules that you shall set before them. <sup>2</sup>When you buy a Hebrew slave, he shall serve six years, and in the seventh he shall go out free, for nothing. <sup>3</sup>If he comes in single, he shall go out single; if he comes in married, then his wife shall go out with him. <sup>4</sup>If his master gives him a wife and she bears him sons or daughters, the wife and her children shall be her master's, and he shall go out alone. <sup>5</sup>But if the slave plainly says, 'I love my master, my wife, and my children; I will not go out free,' <sup>6</sup>then his master shall bring him to the door or the doorpost. And his master shall bore his ear through with an awl, and he shall be his slave forever.
