1: Pray

1 Timothy 2:1-4

¹Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, ²for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. ³For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, ⁴who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

1 Timothy 2:1-4 (The Message)

¹⁻³The first thing I want you to do is pray. Pray every way you know how, for everyone you know. Pray especially for rulers and their governments to rule well so we can be quietly about our business of living simply, in humble contemplation. This is the way our Savior God wants us to live.

2: Engage constructively

Daniel 5:11

¹¹There is a man in your kingdom in whom is the Spirit of the Holy God. And in the days of your father, light and understanding and wisdom, like the wisdom of the gods, were found in him; and King Nebuchadnezzar your father—your father the king—made him chief of the magicians, astrologers, Chaldeans, and soothsayers.

¹⁴Do all things without complaining and disputing, ¹⁵that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, ¹⁶holding fast the word of life, so that I may rejoice in the day of Christ that I have not run in vain or labored in vain.

3: Vote

Proverbs 29:2

²When the righteous are in authority, the people rejoice; but when a wicked man rules, the people groan.

- Since we don't vote for individuals personal character becomes irrelevant and organisational culture & party policy becomes crucial.
- You'll vote according to who you most identify with – where your strongest allegiance lies.
- Alternatively your vote will reveal your allegiance.
- Someone to speak in your stead
- You will have few opportunities to demonstrate your devotion to Christ as clearly as at an election.
- Seek first the Kingdom

Matthew 6:31-33

³¹“Therefore do not worry, saying, ‘What shall we eat?’ or ‘What shall we drink?’ or ‘What shall we wear?’ ³²For after all these things the Gentiles seek. For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. ³³But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

- Seek first the Kingdom
- At what stage does Matthew 6:33 no longer apply?
- When finance wins out over morality, everybody ends up poorer
- Make your vote an act of faith, not an act of fear

¹⁷Honor all people. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honor the king.
