(Joh 1:7) He came as a witness, to bear witness about the light, that all might believe through him.


(Joh 1:8) He was not the light, but came to bear witness about the light.

(Joh 1:10) He was in the world, and the world was made through him, yet the world did not know him.


(Joh 1:11) He came to his own, and his own people did not receive him.



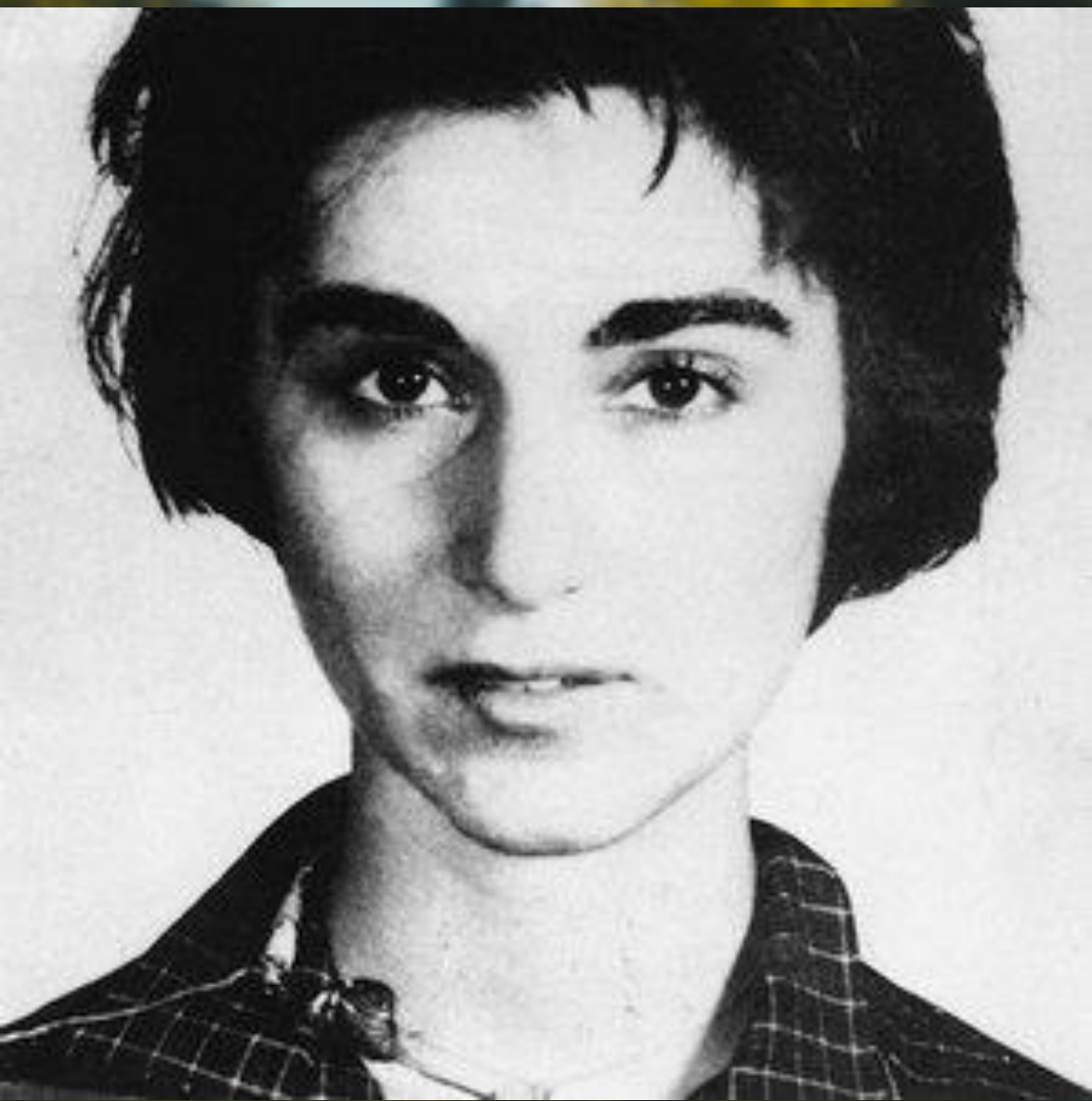
(Joh 1:12) But to all who did receive him,






