


(Php 3:2) Look out for the dogs, look out for the evildoers, look out for those who mutilate the flesh.







## The passive obedience of Jesus

(Eph 2:8) For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God

(Isa 53:5) But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed. (Isa 53:6) All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

## Passive and Active Obedience of Christ:

(Rom 5:18) Therefore, as one trespass led to condemnation for all men, so one act of righteousness leads to justification and life for all men. (Rom 5:19) For as by the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, so by the one man's obedience the many will be made righteous.



## Man Focused Righteousness

The Gospel (Gods Righteousness)

Passive obedience

Mutilate the flesh: Physically "Circumcise" yourself to pay for your sins (earn forgiveness)


Receive God's Forgiveness (Justification) in the Spirit, Through the Death of Jesus

Active obedience

Mutilate the heart: as you try to earn God's favour by building or relying on your own a "moral record", it breaks you (Rom 10:3)

I am favoured by God because of the righteousness of Jesus. I no longer rely on my own life, but I receive the sinless life of Jesus as my own (Phil 3:9)





## Understanding Righteousness: The key to being free in God

- 1. I am free from the burden to pay for my own sins
- 2. I am free to live for Jesus without the fear of failing or letting God down. Since it is not my life that makes me righteous, but the life of Jesus



(Heb 4:10) for whoever has entered God's rest has also rested from his works as God did from his.

(Heb 4:11) Let us therefore strive to enter that rest, so that no one may fall by the same sort of disobedience.

(Heb 4:16) Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.
