#### In the days of Noah

Mathew 24:37-39 <sup>37</sup> For as were the days of Noah, so will be the coming of the Son of Man. <sup>38</sup> For as in those days before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day when Noah entered the ark, <sup>39</sup> and they were unaware until the flood came and swept them all away, so will be the coming of the Son of Man.

## What was it like?

**Genesis 6:1-4** When man began to multiply on the face of the land and daughters were born to them, <sup>2</sup> the sons of God saw that the daughters of man were attractive. And they took as their wives any they chose. <sup>3</sup> Then the LORD said, "My Spirit shall not abide in man forever, for he is flesh: his days shall be 120 years." <sup>4</sup> The Nephilim were on the earth in those days, and also afterward, when the sons of God came in to the daughters of man and they bore children to them. These were the mighty men who were of old, the men of renown.

**2 Peter 2:4-5** <sup>4</sup> For if <u>God did not spare angels when they sinned</u>, but <u>cast them into hell</u> and committed them to chains of gloomy darkness to be kept until the judgment; <sup>5</sup> if <u>he did not spare the ancient world</u>, <u>but preserved No</u>ah, a <u>herald of righteousness</u>, with <u>seven others</u>, when he brought a flood upon the world of the ungodly

### All had sinned

**Genesis 6:5-7** <sup>5</sup> The LORD saw that the <u>wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every intention of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. <sup>6</sup> And the LORD regretted that he had made man on the earth, and <u>it grieved him to his heart</u>. <sup>7</sup> So the LORD said, "I will blot out man whom I have created from the face of the land, man and animals and creeping things and birds of the heavens, for I am sorry that I have made them."</u>

#### Noah walked with God

**Genesis 6:8-10** But Noah found favour in the eyes of the LORD. These are the generations of Noah. Noah was a righteous man, blameless in his generation. Noah walked with God. And Noah had three sons, Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

#### Sin will corrupt man

**Genesis 6:11-12** <sup>11</sup> Now the earth was corrupt in God's sight, and the earth was <u>filled with violence</u>. <sup>12</sup> And God saw the earth, and behold, it was corrupt, for <u>all flesh had corrupted their way</u> on the earth.

#### The result of sin is death

**Genesis 6:13**. And God said to Noah, "I have determined to make an end of all flesh, for the earth is filled with violence through them all destroy them with the earth.

#### But the gift of God is everlasting live

**Genesis 6:14** Make yourself an ark of gopher wood. Make rooms in the ark, and cover it inside and out with pitch.

#### Judgement has 2 sides

**Genesis 6:17-18** <sup>17</sup> For behold, I will bring a flood of waters upon the earth to destroy all flesh in which is the breath of life under heaven. Everything that is on the earth shall die. <sup>18</sup> But I will establish my covenant with you, and you shall come into the ark, you, your sons, your wife, and your sons' wives with you.

## Noah's righteousness was by faith

**Genesis 7:1** Then the LORD said to Noah, "Go into the ark, you and all your household, for I have seen that you are righteous before me in this generation.

Hebrews 11:6-7 <sup>6</sup> And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God <u>must believe that he exists</u> and that <u>he rewards those who seek him</u>. <sup>7</sup> By faith Noah, being warned by God concerning events as yet unseen, <u>in reverent fear constructed an ark for the saving of his household</u>. By this he condemned the world and <u>became an heir of the righteousness that comes by faith</u>.

#### Enter the door to be saved

John 10:9 <u>I am the door</u>. If anyone <u>enters</u> by me, <u>he will be saved</u> and will go in and out and find pasture.

#### Noah was obedient

**Genesis 7:4-5** <sup>4</sup> For in seven days I will send rain on the earth forty days and forty nights, and every living thing that I have made I will blot out from the face of the ground." <sup>5</sup> And Noah did all that the LORD had commanded him.

## The good news

**1 Peter 3:18-20** <sup>18</sup> For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive in the spirit, <sup>19</sup> in which he went and proclaimed to the spirits in prison, <sup>20</sup> because they formerly did not obey, when God's patience waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight persons, were brought safely through water.

**Genesis 9:1, 8-9** <sup>1</sup> And <u>God blessed Noah and his sons</u> and said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth.<sup>8</sup> Then God said to Noah and to his sons with him, <sup>9</sup> "Behold, <u>I establish my covenant with</u> you and your <u>offspring</u> after you,
