on your nose and earrings

Eze 16:13 Thus you were adorned with gold and silver, and your clothing was of fine linen and silk and embroidered cloth. You ate fine flour and honey and oil. You grew exceedingly beautiful and advanced to royalty.

renown went forth among
the nations because of
your beauty, for it was
perfect through the
splendor that I had
bestowed on you, declares
the Lord GOD.

Eze 16:15 "But you trusted in your beauty and played the whore because of your renown and lavished your whorings on any passerby; your beauty became his.

Isa 62:3 You shall be a
crown of beauty in the hand
of the LORD, and a **royal**
diadem in the hand of your
God.

Isa 62:4 You shall no more
be termed Forsaken, and
your land shall no more be
termed Desolate, but you
shall be called My Delight Is
in Her, and your land
Married; for the LORD

1Pe 2:9 But you are a chosen race, a **royal priesthood**, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.

1Pe 2:10 Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

1Co 4:7 For who sees
anything different in you?
What do you have that you
did not receive? If then you
received it, why do you boast
as if you did not receive it?

1Co 4:8 Already you have
all you want! Already you
have **become rich!** Without
us you have **become kings!**
And would that you did
reign, so that we might
share the **rule** with you!

Col 2:9 For in him the whole
fullness of deity dwells
bodily,

filled in him, who is the head
of all rule and authority.

Gen 4:7 If you do well, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well, sin is crouching at the door. Its desire is for you, but you **must rule over it.**"

Rom 6:13 Do not present your members to sin as instruments for unrighteousness, but present yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life, and your members to God as instruments for righteousness.
